Planned Site Works

Work is progressing well on the houses, with timber frames and roofing now underway. Windows, doors, and internal trades are scheduled to commence in the coming weeks. Structural work to the ground floor of the apartment block is on track for completion by the end of October 2025. This will enable the start of the brick and block construction works.

We remain committed to keeping disruption to a minimum for residents. With the colder, wetter months approaching, dust, soil, and mud are being managed through regular road sweeping, and we are ensuring that the agreed traffic management routes are always followed.

Thank you for your continued patience and understanding whilst the works are ongoing - it is greatly appreciated.

The site gates will continue to open from 7:30am, and a gate attendant will be on hand to manage access. This helps ensure that delivery and collection vehicles come straight onto site, and that the site team park within the premises.
